The Microsoft High School Intern Program is an 8-10 week summer program focused on creating an enriching environment for local students who want exposure to the field of software engineering. The program provides challenging but achievable projects that will encourage approximately 20 juniors and seniors to continue in the field of technology. High school is a critical age in which many of our students are already starting to pick their career path, and we want to be sure we use this chance to introduce them to the opportunities that Microsoft and technology will offer.

All Puget Sound area high school students are welcome to apply. We especially encourage applications from minorities (African American, Native American, Hispanic), young women, individuals with disabilities, and students from economically disadvantaged families.

Requirements to Apply:

- Be a high school junior or senior in the Puget Sound area (at the time of application)
- Have a demonstrated interest in technology
- Know how to e-mail and use Microsoft Office Word
- Have a basic grasp of HTML, Visual Basic, or other programming language (preferred)
- Be 16 years old and a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Be available to work full time, 40 hours per week, for eight to ten consecutive weeks starting on June 24, 2013
