- This is an exciting full day event. Most students will be learning to use TouchDevelopment. You will get to work with Microsoft volunteers and UW computer science students. Pizza lunch will be provided as well as prizes and other goodies. ## - Before attending, you must:

- 1. Pick up a permission slip from Mr. Bergquist (Room 115a)
- 2. Provide me with your email, experience level (likely Apprentice), if you have a Metro Card, and what device you can brining (none I can reserve one for you, iPad/Tablet, Smart Phone, or Laptop w/ Chrome), more details below and at <u>www.AppDay.org</u>.
- 3. Return a fully signed permission slip by end of day Monday May 20<sup>th</sup> (so I can insure chaperone arrangements).
- 4. You must register on www.AppDay.org for the event (link on page is: <u>http://bit.ly/TQbynh</u>) For teacher details use: Earl Bergquist, <u>embergquist@seattleschools.org</u>, 206-252-2424.
- 5. Please set up your device beforehand (if you are brining one):
  - a. You will need a valid account with either Google or Microsoft (LiveID or Hotmail)
  - Test your device compatibility: Browse to <u>https://www.touchdevelop.com/app</u>. TouchDevelop will automatically detect if the device is compatible or what to do to make it work. If TouchDevelop successfully loads, the device is ready for AppDay. TouchDevelop will continue to work even when offline.
  - c. If you have any trouble with this, check with Mr. Bergquist in advance for some guidance.

Departure: we will be meeting out front Garfield at 8am, preferably a bit earlier, and you will be assigned to a chaperone's group, then go down to Martin L King Jr Way & E Cherry St to take the #8 route Metro bus down to Rainier Beach High School via the Seward Park Ave S & S Fisher PI stop.
Return: we will again be using the #8 route Metro, which will hopefully get most students back before 2:30pm. We will do our best to get students on the earlier bus, but since we are dependent on public transportation, we could incur unforeseen delays.

**Bus Details:** we will be using the #8 route Metro Bus

Departing from Martin L King Jr Way & E Cherry St using Metro Bus Route #8:

- At 08:05 AM - Arrives Seward Park Ave S & S Fisher PI At 08:43 AM

- At 08:20 AM - Arrives Seward Park Ave S & S Fisher PI At 08:57 AM

Then walk 0.1 mile N to RAINIER BEACH HIGH SCHOOL at 8815 S Seward Park Ave Returning: Leave Rainier Beach HS about 1:15, we will walk 0.3 mile to Depart S Henderson St & Rainier Ave S:

- Leaving at 1:23 PM to arrive Martin L King Jr Way & E Cherry St about 01:53 PM

- Leaving at 1:53 PM to arrive Martin L King Jr Way & E Cherry St about 02:23 PM Walk back up to Garfield HS. <u>We will do our best to get students on the first bus, but since we are</u> dependent on Public transportation, we could incur unforeseen delays.
