Apps for Good Students Code of Conduct

When using the Apps for Good platform, you will generally be working with teachers, students and experts known to Apps for Good. However, you should still practice good online safety when working on Apps for Good and be aware you are working with both adults and teenagers on this site. Here are some guidelines to follow and things to remember:

- 1. Never use your full name or give out personal details to other users on the platform. You can use your team name and you and your teammates' first names or aliases, but do not give out your surname, address, phone number, etc.**
- 2. All email communication with the Experts should be through your teacher. Do not contact others via mobile calls, texts, etc. You can be friendly, but keep the focus on the Apps for Good work.**
3. If your school uses Skype to work with the Experts, only use this in school, only between Apps for Good teams, staff or experts, and make sure your teacher logs the call and is in the room.
4. Keep your Apps for Good log-on details safe and do not give it out to people who are not taking part in Apps for Good.
- 5. Remember that anything you post on the Apps for Good site can be seen by other students, teachers, experts and even your Head teacher. Don't put anything on the site that could cause embarrassment, offense or would be against school/college rules. Obey any parent requests to not post students' images, videos and full names.**
6. Be honest and enjoy the site, but don't put comments and send messages to other teams or experts that could hurt someone's feelings or cause offense.
- 7. If you see or receive any comments or links that you are unsure about, worry or upset you, let your teacher know as soon as possible and he/she will help you with this.**
