

Problem-solving ideas



- Simple solution to a common problem
- Task based
- Make life easier/ more enjoyable

ASK: What apps make your life easier? So we can find great ideas, hiding within problems that we face on a regular basis.



Problem-solving example

- Problem: School Officer elections on paper are prone to fraud and take time to count votes.
- Key insight: every student has a unique log in that could be used for online for voting.
- Solution: the SPS Voting WebApp, allows ASB to set up voting online using student log in to prevent fraud, and results are tallied automatically!








Evolutionary Mash-Up example

- Inspired by new innovations in hardware functionality






