## Qualifications

- High school juniors and seniors in Western Washington
- Have demonstrated an interest in technology
- Be at least 16 years old and have a legal right to work in the U.S. for the duration of the internship (not required for the high school boot camp)
- Be available to work full-time for 10 consecutive weeks (June 24 - August 30, 2019)
- All high school students in Western Washington are welcome to apply.

  - If you are a Senior and have been accepted to any colleges/ universities, please name the college or university.
  - Please list any Computer Science classes you have completed or relevant technical accomplishments.
  - Essay Question #1: Please describe how you demonstrate your passion for technology inside or outside of the classroom.
  - Essay Question #2: How do you see technology or the lack of technology empowering or disempowering people in your community?
  - Essay Question #3: Leadership is an important skill at Microsoft. Please tell us about a time when you demonstrated the characteristics of a leader in your school or community.
